Two identified criteria were eliminated from the analysis for the following reasons:

Variety of Programs: This criteria was added by the Advisory Committee during the initial program analysis of the 17 program categories. It was intended to identify variety within that category as a way of being able to compare categories amongst one another. Now that the 17 program categories have been split into 49 sub-programs, the project team believes this criteria is no longer valid to the scoring.

**Demographics:** Since the 49 programs are categorized based on age, their multigenerational nature can't be measured as part of the scoring. The remaining demographic data, resident / non-resident split, the project team recommends excluding from the scoring due to the historically regional appeal of the programs.
