

Specialized Recreation Day Camp

Medication Protocol

The City of Walnut Creek's Specialized Recreation Day Camps request that medication is administered outside of camp hours if possible. For routine medication(s) that must be administered during camp hours or emergency medication(s) that need to be stored onsite, we request the following:

- 1. A medication authorization form to be filled out (either paper or in ePACT) and returned prior to the start of camp.
- 2. Medication is handed directly to a senior staff member before or on the first day of camp.
- 3. Campers are not authorized to store medication (routine or emergency) on their persons during camp.
- 4. Additional medication plans or seizure action plans written by a doctor to be submitted if available.

Camp staff is not authorized to administer any injectable medication besides an EpiPen in the case of an emergency. If a routine medication dose has failed to be administered for any reason, staff will contact the camper's care provider for instruction.
