



Specialized Recreation Day Camp
Camper Behavior Contract

The City of Walnut Creek takes pride in creating safe and fun environments for camp participants. Guardians and campers should review the following camp behavior contract prior to the first day of camp.

1. Campers need to stay with their group. This includes not leaving an area without permission from staff in addition to exiting an area when instructed by a staff.
2. Listen to staff and follow directions.
3. Do not enter areas that staff have instructed you to stay away from or that are marked by red tape.
4. Do not hit, fight, bite, spit on, or inappropriately touch other campers or staff.
5. Use appropriate language with other staff and campers.
6. Respect the camp property along with other camper's personal property.
7. Do not share or trade food with other campers.
8. Use an inside voice while indoors.
9. Refrain from demonstrating inappropriate toileting behavior that threatens the health and safety of other campers.

Failure to follow the outlined behavior contract will result in an unsafe environment for you, other campers, and staff. Depending on the severity and/or frequency of violations of this behavior contract, the following consequences may occur:

- Verbal warning from a staff member.
- Written warning and conversation with guardian.
- Sent home immediately for the day.
- Suspension from camp.
- Dismissal from camp.

Please note that campers are not eligible for a refund if they are suspended or dismissed from camp.
